2020 Annual General Meeting

Dear Fellow Investor,

On behalf of the board of directors (**Board**) of VGI Partners Asian Investments Limited ACN 635 219 484 (**Company**), I am delighted to invite you to the inaugural annual general meeting (**AGM**) of the Company.

The AGM will be held online at https://web.lumiagm.com/378636365 at 3:00pm (AEDT) on Monday, 16 November 2020. There will not be a physical venue for shareholders to attend. The Company is relying on the Corporations (Coronavirus Economic Response) Determination (No. 1) 2020 to hold the virtual AGM, given the uncertainty and potential health risks associated with large gatherings during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Enclosed for your attention you will find:

- the notice of meeting (**Notice of Meeting**) and explanatory memorandum containing further information with respect to the business to be considered at the AGM (**Explanatory Memorandum**);
- a proxy form for the AGM (Proxy Form); and
- a guide to attending the virtual AGM (AGM Guide).

The formal AGM is part of a broader program of activity outlined overleaf. If you plan to attend the virtual AGM, we encourage you to also join the Portfolio Manager's presentation at 10:00am (AEDT) in order to hear and ask questions about the portfolio. Details on how to participate in the Portfolio Manager's presentation and AGM are set out in the AGM Guide. There is also a listen-only telephone facility for the AGM. The dial-in facilities for this are similarly in the AGM Guide. Shareholders should be aware that they cannot vote or ask questions via the AGM dial-in facility and if you are dialing in you should ensure to vote ahead of the AGM.

Business of the AGM

The business of the AGM is set out in the Notice of Meeting.

The Board encourages you to vote in favour of all resolutions set out below.

Notice is given that VGI Partners Asian Investments Limited ACN 635 219 484 (**Company**) will hold its inaugural annual general meeting (**AGM**) of shareholders of the Company (**Shareholders**) online at https://web.lumiagm.com/378636365 at 3:00pm (AEDT) on Monday, 16 November 2020.

Business to be considered at the AGM

Item 1: Consideration of financial statements and reports

To receive and consider the annual report, financial statements, directors' report and auditor's report of the Company for the financial period ended 30 June 2020 (**FY20**).

Please note that this item of business is for discussion only and there is no requirement for Shareholders to approve these reports.

Resolution 1: Adoption of the FY20 Remuneration Report

To consider and if thought fit pass the following as a non-binding ordinary resolution:

"That, for the purposes of section 250R(2) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) and for all other purposes, the remuneration report of the Company as contained in the Company's annual report for the financial period ended 30 June 2020 be adopted."

A voting exclusion statement for this resolution is set out on page 3 of this notice of AGM (**Notice of Meeting**) and further information on this resolution is set out in the explanatory memorandum which accompanies and forms part of this Notice of Meeting (**Explanatory Memorandum**).

Please note that the vote on this resolution is non-binding.

Resolution 2: Re-election of Mr. David Jones as a director of the Company

To consider and if thought fit pass the following resolution as an ordinary resolution:

"That Mr. David Jones, a Director who, pursuant to Clause 59 of the Company's Constitution holds office until the end of this annual general meeting and, being eligible, offers himself for re-election, be re-elected as a Director of the Company."

The Explanatory Memorandum sets out further information on this resolution.

Resolution 3: Re-election of Mr. Robert Luciano as a director of the Company

To consider and if thought fit pass the following resolution as an ordinary resolution:

"That Mr. Robert Luciano, a Director who, pursuant to Clause 60.1 of the Company's Constitution, retires by rotation and offers himself for re-election, be re-elected as a Director of the Company."

The Explanatory Memorandum sets out further information on this resolution.



Resolution 4: Appointment of the Company's auditor

To consider and if thought fit pass the following resolution as an ordinary resolution:

"That, for the purposes of section 327B(1) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) and for all other purposes, Pitcher Partners, having consented in writing to act as auditor of the Company, be appointed as auditor of the Company with effect from the close of the annual general meeting and that pursuant to section 331 of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth), Pitcher Partners be paid reasonable remuneration as agreed between Pitcher Partners and the board of directors of the Company."

Voting Exclusion Statement

Resolution 1 (Remuneration Report)

Pursuant to sections 250BD and 250R of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) (**Corporations Act**), the Company will disregard any votes cast on Resolution 1:

- by or on behalf of a member of the Company's key management personnel (KMP) whose remuneration
 details are included in the Company's remuneration report for the financial period ended 30 June 2020
 (Remuneration Report) or their closely related parties, regardless of the capacity in which the vote is
 cast; or
- as a proxy by a person who is a member of the Company's KMP at the date of the AGM or their closely related parties,

unless the vote is cast as a proxy for a person entitled to vote on Resolution 1:

- in accordance with a direction in the proxy form (Proxy Form); or
- by the Chair of the AGM, provided the proxy appointment expressly authorises the Chair to exercise the
 proxy even if the resolution is connected directly or indirectly with the remuneration of a member of the
 Company's KMP.

Voting Information

Pursuant to clause 40.2(c) of the Company's Constitution, and section 5(c) of the *Corporations (Coronavirus Economic Response) Determination (No. 1) 2020*, the Chair will put all resolutions to a poll. Results of the voting on the resolutions will be announced to the ASX as soon as practicable after the AGM.

Entitlement to vote

In accordance with section 1074E(2)(g)(i) of the Corporations Act and regulation 7.11.37 of the *Corporations Regulations 2001* (Cth), the Company has determined that for the purpose of the AGM, all shares in the capital of the Company will be taken to be held by the persons who held them as registered holders at 7:00pm (AEDT) on Saturday 14 November 2020. Accordingly, share transfers registered after that time will be disregarded in determining entitlements to attend and vote at the virtual AGM.

Proxies

A Shareholder entitled to attend and vote at the virtual AGM is entitled to appoint not more than two proxies to attend and vote in their place. A proxy does not need to be a Shareholder. If a Shareholder appoints two proxies, the Shareholder may specify the proportion or number of votes each proxy is entitled to exercise. If no proportion or number of votes is specified, each proxy may exercise half of the Shareholder's votes. If the specified proportion or number of votes exceeds that which the Shareholder is entitled to, each proxy may exercise half of the Shareholder's votes. Any fractions of votes brought about by the apportionment of votes to a proxy will be disregarded.

Explanatory Memorandum

This Explanatory Memorandum provides Shareholders with important information in relation to each item of business for the AGM, including the proposed resolutions to be considered by Shareholders of the Company.

Terms and abbreviations defined in the Notice of Meeting have the same meaning when used in this Explanatory Memorandum.

Financial statements and reports (not voted on)

The business of the AGM will include the receipt and consideration of the Company's annual report, financial statements, directors' report and the auditor's report for the financial period ended 30 June 2020 (**Reports**) as required by section 317 of the Corporations Act. The Reports are included in the Company's annual report, which was lodged with the ASX on 20 August 2020.

A copy of the annual report is available from the Company's website at www.vgipartners.com/lics/vg8.

Neither the Corporations Act, nor the Company's Constitution, require a vote of Shareholders on the Reports. However, Shareholders will be given a reasonable opportunity to ask questions and make comments in relation to both the Reports and the business and management of the Company.

Shareholders will also be given a reasonable opportunity to ask questions of a representative of the Company's auditor, Pitcher Partners, relevant to the conduct of the audit, the preparation and content of the Company's financial statements and auditor's report, the accounting policies adopted by the Company in relation to the preparation of the financial statements and the independence of the auditor in relation to the conduct of the audit.

Resolution 1: Adoption of the FY20 Remuneration Report (non-binding resolution)

Resolution 1 provides Shareholders the opportunity to vote on the Company's Remuneration Report. Under section 250R(2) of the Corporations Act, the Company must put the adoption of the Remuneration Report to a vote at its AGM. The Remuneration Report forms part of the directors' report and is set out in the Company's annual report for the financial period ended 30 June 2020 on pages 11 to 12.

The Remuneration Report describes the policies of the board of directors of the Company (**Board**) in relation to the nature and level of remuneration paid to the Company's directors. Messrs. Robert Luciano and Douglas Tynan are directors of VGI Partners Limited, the parent company of the investment manager of the Company's investment portfolio, and do not receive directors' fees directly from the Company.

While the vote on the Remuneration Report is advisory only and does not bind the directors or the Company, the Board will take the outcome of the vote into account when considering the Company's future remuneration arrangements.

Additionally, under the Corporations Act, if 25% or more of the votes cast are against the adoption of the Remuneration Report at two consecutive annual general meetings, Shareholders will be required to vote at the second of those annual general meetings on a resolution (**Spill Resolution**) that another meeting be held within 90 days (**Spill Meeting**) at which all of the Company's directors, other than the managing director, will cease to hold office unless re-elected at the Spill Meeting. The Spill Resolution is an ordinary resolution.



Shareholders will be given a reasonable opportunity at the AGM to ask questions about, and make comments on, the Remuneration Report.

The voting exclusion statement for Resolution 1 is set out on page 3 of the Notice of Meeting.

The Board unanimously recommends that Shareholders vote in favour of adopting the Remuneration Report.

Resolution 2: Re-election of Mr. David Jones as a director of the Company

Mr. David Jones was appointed by the Directors (who were in office at the relevant time) to the Board on 25 September 2020 to fill the position vacated by the resignation of Mr. Douglas Tynan in accordance with clause 59.1 of the Company's Constitution.

Clause 59.2 of the Company's Constitution provides that a Director appointed under clause 59.1 of the Company's Constitution to fill a casual vacancy on the Board will hold office until the end of the next annual general meeting of the Company, at which time the Director may be re-elected.

Having regard to the above, the Board has determined that Mr. David Jones is required to retire from office at the AGM in accordance with the requirements of clause 59.2 of the Company's Constitution.

Mr. David Jones, being eligible, will stand for re-election as a director of the Company at the AGM.

The experience, skills and qualifications of Mr. David Jones are as follows:

Qualifications: B.Eng. (1st Class Hons) (Melb.), MBA (Harvard)

Experience and expertise: Mr. Jones has more than 30 years' experience in investment markets, the

majority as a general partner in private equity firms, and prior to that in general management and management consulting. Mr. Jones has been a board member of numerous private and public businesses, including a number in the wealth

management sector.

Other current directorships: Mr. Jones is a Director of VGI Partners Limited and Chairman of VGI Partners

Global Investments Limited.

Former directorships Mr. Jones was a Director of Global Sources Limited (NASDAQ: GSOL) from

(last three years) 2001 to 19 August 2017.

The Board (excluding Mr. David Jones due to his conflict of interest) unanimously supports the re-election of Mr. David Jones and recommends that Shareholders **vote in favour** of Resolution 2.

Resolution 3: Re-election of Mr. Robert Luciano as a director of the Company

Clause 60.1 of the Company's Constitution provides that at the close of each annual general meeting, one-third of the Directors or, if their number is not a multiple of three, then the number nearest to but not more than one-third of the Directors, must retire by rotation. In accordance with the Company's Constitution, Directors seeking re-election as a result of their appointment to fill a casual vacancy on the Board, are not included in determining the number of Directors which must retire by rotation. Accordingly, Mr. David Jones (who offers himself for re-election at the AGM having been previously appointed to fill a casual vacancy on the Board) is not included in the calculation of those Directors who are to retire by rotation in accordance with clause 60.1 of



the Company's Constitution.

Clause 60.2 of the Company's Constitution states that the Directors to retire in accordance with clause 60.1 must be those who have been longest in office since their last election.

Having regard to the above, the Board has determined that Mr. Robert Luciano is required to retire from office in accordance with clause 60 of the Company's Constitution.

Mr. Robert Luciano, being eligible, will stand for re-election as a director of the Company at the AGM.

The experience, skills and qualifications of Mr. Robert Luciano are as follows:

Qualifications: B.Com (Acc/Fin) (UNSW), M.Com (Fin) (UNSW), F Fin, CFA

Experience and expertise: Mr. Luciano founded VGI Partners in 2008. He has more than 25 years'

experience as a portfolio manager, equities analyst and accountant.

Other current directorships: Mr. Luciano is Executive Chairman of VGI Partners Limited and a Director of

VGI Partners Global Investments Limited.

Former directorships Mr. Luciano has not held any other directorships of listed companies within

(last three years): the last 3 years.

The Board (excluding Mr. Robert Luciano due to his conflict of interest) unanimously supports the re-election of Mr. Robert Luciano and recommend that Shareholders **vote in favour** of Resolution 3.

Resolution 4: Appointment of the Company's auditor

Pitcher Partners was appointed as the Company's auditor on 6 August 2019. In accordance with the Corporations Act, Pitcher Partners holds office as auditor of the Company until the Company's first annual general meeting.

Section 327B(1)(a) of the Corporations Act requires a public company to appoint an auditor at its first annual general meeting. Accordingly, the Company is seeking shareholder approval for the appointment of Pitcher Partners as auditor of the Company pursuant to Resolution 4.

In accordance with section 328B of the Corporations Act, a Shareholder has nominated Pitcher Partners to be appointed as the Company's auditor. A copy of the nomination is attached to this Explanatory Memorandum as Annexure A.

Pitcher Partners has given its written consent to act as the Company's auditor and has not withdrawn its consent subject to Shareholder approval of Resolution 4.

The Board unanimously recommends that Shareholders vote in favour of Resolution 4.
